Below are a list of fonts we recommend and feel work well in both contemporary and traditional invites.

We recommend you print these pages if you are able to see them as they would look in print.

We do not recommend using fancy fonts throughout as they become very hard to read particularly with dates, postcodes and web addresses etc.

We strongly suggest that you choose either entire text from the typeset fonts page or accent certain parts of the text with the fancy fonts listed separately.

The accent font is usually the one we will take through the remainder of your stationery – for example place cards and table names but this is always your choice!
